

CAPRIOLE GOAT CHEESE

Retail Care Suggestions for Capriole's Ripened Cheeses



We think we've devised the perfect solution for shipping **fragile, ripened cheeses** so they can breathe and yet be protected in transit. We ship in poplar cheese crates produced by a local farmer and line each crate with cheese paper. They're reused in many a fine cheese case and provide an artisanal visual to customers.

How can you best care for these cheeses in order to increase shelf life and cut down on waste?

The ideal scenario for Wabash Cannonballs, Sofia, Piper's Pyramides, and Flora is to present them **in their poplar crates, behind glass, in a cut-to-order case**, with their crates overwrapped with plastic. Better yet, apply color labels to the top and nutritionals to the bottom of the paper wrapped cheeses. In a **reach-in case**, individual paper-wrapped cheeses can be overwrapped with crystal paper or plastic wrap.



Wabash Cannonballs come unwrapped in their crates. At 3-4 oz., they dry out quickly in paper and are best wrapped in crystal wrap or in individual containers. This also works well for Piper's Pyramides and cuts of Sofia.
